

Framing

What is your goal for your portraits? To complete the portrait presentation, you should have it properly framed. Whether you need a dramatic focal point for a room or an accent in a corner or foyer, I have a frame solution for you. No matter whether you frame one large portrait or several small ones, the images we have captured will be displayed proudly.

Designer Frame Collections:

These frames have a coordinated double-mat to enhance the moulding and image for a layered and professional finish. Choose from frame mouldings that are black, black & gold, silver, gold, silver & gold, gold & bronze, wood, colored wood and white. There are many mouldings and mats, including mat upgrades, that will fit your home décor while simultaneously complimenting the style of your wall portrait.

I offer three classifications/sizes to fit all your needs:

Slim Line: These frames are generally 1” wide. They are good for smaller prints.

Deluxe Line: These frames are generally 2” wide and are the most popular line. They are great for 8X10 prints on up to 20X24 wall portraits. The mat border you choose goes hand in hand with the size moulding you choose. So as long as your mat border is 2-3” wide, these deluxe mouldings work great. This line, since it is the most versatile, has the most mouldings to choose from.

Artisan Line: These frames are generally 3” wide. I recommend these for prints 16X20 and up since you don’t want the frame to overpower the print. These mouldings help make a statement with a portrait you want to be a focal point in an entire room.

Mats: There are over 50 standard double mat combinations to choose from; plenty to coordinate your frame and portrait.

Upgraded Mats:

Tuscan: If you want to add more detail, more elegance, and more *presence*, upgrade to a Tuscan Mat. This unique upgrade option has a small decorative wood trim, called a fillet, added to the mat opening. This creates a striking look that will compliment any image. There are 25 coordinating mat & fillet options to choose from, many of which have fillets that exactly match your moulding choices.

Raphael: Take the upgrade one step further and add a liner mat to separate the fillet from the image. This liner can exactly match or coordinate it with a different color. This look adds an extra touch of class to your framed portrait presentation.

Creative Collages:

These offer exciting ways to present a grouping of prints. The frames offer a single mat containing multiple print openings encased in a beautiful frame. Your images can be stacked, in a row, or in pinwheel formation. There are many different layouts to choose from so please ask to see the Layout Guide for more freestyling collage options.
